Toman (ASN: 0-1181169), United States Army, was awarded the Silver Star (Posthumously) for conspicuous gallantry and intrepidity in connection with military operations against the enemy in Korea, while serving with Battery A, 37th Field Artillery Battalion, 2d Infantry Division, on 26 September 1951.
