(Citation Needed) - SYNOPSIS: First Lieutenant (Field Artillery) Donald L. Mushik, United States Army, was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross for extraordinary heroism in connection with military operations against an armed enemy while serving as a Forward Observer with the Field Artillery, 43d Infantry Division, in action against enemy forces on 23 July 1943, on Horseshoe Mountain, New Georgia, Solomon Islands. Lieutenant Mushik accurately adjusted 14 artillery concentrations under extremely heavy fire. His intrepid actions, personal bravery and zealous devotion to duty exemplify the highest traditions of the military forces of the United States and reflect great credit upon himself, the 43d Infantry Division, and the United States Army.
