CPT Schneider was serving as the Battery Commander of Battery D, 1st Battalion, 82nd Artillery, Americal Division at the time of his death, the victim of a fragging incident.

At approximately 0140 hours on August 17, 1970 and individual threw an M-67 fragmentation grenade into his living quarters. He was transported to the 27th Surgical Hospital, where he was pronounced dead from fragmentation wounds to the chest.

The perpetrator (PV1 David K. Locklin) was tried by General Courts Martial on October 17, 1970 and entered a plea of un-premeditated murder. He was sentenced to 25 years at hard labor, a dishonorable discharge, reduction to the lowest enlisted grade and forfeiture of all pay and allowances.



3. **HOMICIDE:** Reference UNCLAS RYTO FORD message, AVNFM-70, DTG 200323Z Aug 70, involving CPT Scott H. SCHNEIDER (Victim/Deceased).

4. Investigation disclosed that at approximately 0200 hrs., 17 Aug 70, at Btry D, 1st Bn, 82d Arty, LZ Dottie, RVN, LOCKLIN murdered SCHNEIDER by detonating a M67 fragmentation hand grenade in SCHNEIDER's quarters. LOCKLIN was tried by General Courts Martial on 17 Oct 70 and entered a guilty plea to unpremeditated murder. He was found guilty of unpremeditated murder and was sentenced to 25 years confinement at hard labor, a dishonorable discharge, reduction to the lowest enlisted grade and total forfeiture of all pay and allowances.
