1LT Woehnkler was assigned to Battery C, 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, 19<sup>th</sup> Artillery and was wounded on May 24, 1968 while serving as a Forward Observer for Company D, 2nd Battalion, 8th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division. He died of those wounds on July 18, 1968.

"Cap" and I were together on the Artillery Forward Observer team for D/2/8th Cav, 1st Cav Div. Both of us were wounded on May 24, 1968, in the hills just North of LZ Sharon, in Quang Tri Province, RVN. A hell of an "FO", he was also an all around good guy who was admired, and still is, by the members of D Company.
